



Mountain of Glory

Luke 9:28-36



Luke 9

28 And some eight days after these sayings, it came about that He took along Peter and John and James, and went up to the mountain to pray. 29 And while He was praying, the appearance of His face became different, and His clothing became white and gleaming. 30 And behold, two men were talking with Him; and they were Moses and Elijah, 31 who, appearing in glory, were speaking of His departure which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem. 32 Now Peter and his companions had been overcome with sleep; but when they were fully awake, they saw His glory and the two men standing with Him.

33 And it came about, as these were parting from Him, Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good for us to be here; and let us make three tabernacles: one for You, and one for Moses, and one for Elijah" — not realizing what he was saying. 34 And while he was saying this, a cloud formed and began to overshadow them; and they were afraid as they entered the cloud. 35 And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My Son, My Chosen One; listen to Him!" 36 And when the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone. And they kept silent, and reported to no one in those days any of the things which they had seen.



Timing of God...

- Following the most difficult times, God works!
 - We are more open and ready... and dependent!
 - We have been prepared and awakened
 - We have been shaken off the “other grounds”
- Jesus has been speaking of His purpose – to DIE and be raised
 - Peter has gone from Spirit led, to misled!
 - The need for following and cross-bearing has been given
 - But the thought of Jesus dying, takes center stage

Time for God

- Peter, James and John...
 - Here, Child raising, Gethsemane – intimate times
 - We all need those we can call on...
- Purpose? To pray...
- Things happen when we pray... and when He prays?
 - Face changes first...
 - Clothing gets caught up - the inward revelation becomes outward
 - White, yes... FLASHING like lightning!

Time With God

- Moses and Elijah – appear in splendor/glory - *doxa*
 - Show up like it was a planned meeting...
 - Talking about HIS DEPARTURE! They got it...
- Peter, James and John – caught napping! Hmmmm.....
 - Are we AWAKE for God's moves?
 - Fully awake
 - “they saw His Glory” it was His; not borrowed, but owned
 - What a time to stop and take it in...

Time in God

- Peter...
 - “it is good for us to be here...” like they were needed?
 - Did they need tents set up?
 - “not realizing what he was saying...” wow!
- GOD...
 - A cloud forms, shadow, awe... HIS VOICE!
 - THIS IS MY SON, CHOSEN ONE; LISTEN TO HIM!
