- Pharisees come from Jerusalem... rare!
 - -9:11ff Eating with sinners, fasting; 12:2ff Sabbath; 12:38 signs; 15:1ff washings; 16:1 signs; 17:24ff temple tax...

Marriage question...



- · Not much has changed... marriage still major idea!
 - -peirazo, tempt, make trial
 - -Hillel vs. Shammai liberal vs. conservative
- Deut 24:1~
 - "any reason at all" lit. "every cause"
 - · No matter how Jesus answered, He would offend...

Jesus brings them back



- Gen.2:4 Male and Female, by design!
 - -Leave father/mother; cleave to wife; one flesh
 - -No longer 2 individuals, one... Prov. 5:18; Ecc 9:9; Eph 5:25; 1 Pet. 3:7
 - -Many are divorced, many marriages struggle
 - -Jesus is responding to Jewish thought...
 - -Which causes allows a marriage to end?

from <G4862> (sun) and the base of <G2201> (zeugos); to yoke together, i.e. (figurative) conjoin (in marriage) :- join together.

So why did MOSES... (7)



- But we have an out...! Deut. 24:1-4...
 - -Harness of hearts! Permission is not pleasing God!
 - -Divorce makes it "a civil contract" not a covenant...
 - -From the beginning...
- Except immorality (porneia)... marriage night evidence
 - -Marrying again, adultery... not unforgivable!
