When Jesus Gave Thanks

1Cor 11:24-32



1 Corinthians 11:

23 ¶ For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; 24 and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me." 25 In the same way He took the cup also after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often



1 Corinthians 11:

as you drink it, in remembrance of Me." 26 For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes. 27 Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner, shall be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord. 28 But a man must examine himself, and in so doing he is to eat of the bread and drink of the cup.



1 Corinthians 11:

29 For he who eats and drinks, eats and drinks judgment to himself if he does not judge the body rightly. 30 For this reason many among you are weak and sick, and a number sleep. 31 But if we judged ourselves rightly, we would not be judged. 32 But when we are judged, we are disciplined by the Lord so that we will not be condemned along with the world.

Time of Thanksgiving

- Jesus and giving thanks:
 - Common practice – meals, feasts
 - Plenty Miracles – fish/loaves, Jn 6:11
 - For hearing, Lazarus raised Jn 11:41
 - Passover/Last supper

Thanksgiving

- Command unneeded or unheeded?
 - Levitical offerings; Day/night - 1Ch 23:30
 - David assigned – 1Chronicles 16:7ff
 - Hezekiah's revival 2Ch 30,31
 - Ezra's revival Ezra 3:11ff; Nehemiah 11,12



Luke 22:

14 When the hour had come, He reclined at the table, and the apostles with Him. 15 And He said to them, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer; 16 for I say to you, I shall never again eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God."



Jesus took the bread...

- With great desire He wanted this!
- Washed feet, knows His time!
- And gives thanks???
- *eucharistos* – feel thankful, grateful

This is my BODY

- Blessing over the bread
- Representative of Himself
- One piece shared!
- We partake and become one!

In my BLOOD!

- “In the same way...”
- The New Covenant in Him
- Poured out for many – *aphesis*
- Forgiveness, remission, liberty

Worthy manner?

- Not perfection or “confession” ...
- Examine yourself – scrutinize...
- “judge the body rightly” = ????
