If you 'work' vs. 4

- Wage is not a favor, it is due!
- No work? 'but believes'!
 - Believing what God says is true... (5)
 - "When we do as we should do - faith - we are what we should be!" Grazier
 - God does not 'owe', free gift of grace

No “earning”:

- God:

- Created us out of nothing

- Gives us the power to have faith

- Influences and assists us continually

- Does not reward what He is ultimately doing Himself!

Justifies ungodly vs 6-8

- David speaks the blessings: Ps 32:1,2
 - Blessed are the forgiven
 - Sins covered
 - Sin not taken into account (reckon)
 - Ummm... Blessed are the poor in spirit...

Not in circumcision... 9-12

- Thing that set Jews apart, physically
 - Abraham received the promise 14 years before the 'seal' of circumcision!
 - Abraham was example to Gentiles...
 - "father of all who believe" - pres. act
 - C/Un-c: both groups come by faith!!!

Not by Law 13-16

- Now that works are excluded, Law?
 - “heir of the world” Canaan; Messianic Kingdom; Whole world?
 - If by law, faith is nullified
 - Law doesn’t cause wrath, sin is the reason
 - Faith father...
