Mt 5:19 "Whoever then annuls <3089> one of the least of these commandments, and teaches others *to do* the same, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever keeps and teaches *them*, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

Lu 19:33 As they were untying <3089> the colt, its owners said to them, "Why are you untying <3089> the colt?"

Joh 1:27 "It is He who comes after me, the thong of whose sandal I am not worthy to untie <3089>."

Joh 2:19 Jesus answered them, "Destroy <3089> this temple, and in three days I will raise it up."

Joh 5:18 For this reason therefore the Jews were seeking all the more to kill Him, because He not only was breaking <3089> the Sabbath, but also was calling God His own Father, making Himself equal with God.

Joh 7:23 "If a man receives circumcision on the Sabbath so that the Law of Moses will not be broken <3089>, are you angry with Me because I made an entire man well on the Sabbath?"

Joh 10:35 "If he called them gods, to whom the word of God came (and the Scripture cannot be broken <3089>),

Joh 11:44 The man who had died came forth, bound hand and foot with wrappings, and his face was wrapped around with a cloth. Jesus *said to them, "Unbind <3089> him, and let him go."

Ac 2:24 "But God raised Him up again, putting <3089> an end <3089> to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him to be held in its power.

Ac 7:33 "BUT THE LORD SAID TO HIM, 'TAKE <3089> OFF <3089> THE SANDALS FROM YOUR FEET, FOR THE PLACE ON WHICH YOU ARE STANDING IS HOLY GROUND.

Ac 13:25 "And while John was completing his course, he kept saying, 'What do you suppose that I am? I am not He. But behold, one is coming after me the sandals of whose feet I am not worthy to untie <3089>.'

Ac 13:43 Now when the meeting of the synagogue had broken <3089> up, many of the Jews and of the God-fearing proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas, who, speaking to them, were urging them to continue in the grace of God.

Ac 22:30 But on the next day, wishing to know for certain why he had been accused by the Jews, he released <3089> him and ordered the chief priests and all the Council to assemble, and brought Paul down and set him before them.

Ac 27:41 But striking a reef where two seas met, they ran the vessel aground; and the prow stuck fast and remained immovable, but the stern *began* to be broken <3089> up by the force of *the waves*.

1Co 7:27 Are you bound to a wife? Do not seek to be released. Are you released <3089> from a wife? Do not seek a wife.

Eph 2:14 For He Himself is our peace, who made both *groups into* one and broke <3089> down <3089> the barrier of the dividing wall,

2Pe 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed <3089> with intense heat, and the earth and its works will be burned up.

2Pe 3:11 Since all these things are to be destroyed <3089> in this way, what sort of people ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness,

2Pe 3:12 looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be destroyed <3089> by burning, and the elements will melt with intense heat!
