1 Chronicles 16:

⁸ Oh give thanks to the LORD, call upon His name; Make known His deeds among the peoples. ⁹ Sing to Him, sing praises to Him; Speak of all His wonders. ¹⁰ Glory in His holy name; Let the heart of those who seek the LORD be glad. ¹¹ Seek the LORD and His strength; Seek His face continually. ¹² Remember His wonderful deeds which He has done, His marvels and the judgments from His mouth, ¹³ O seed of Israel



1 Chronicles 16:

His servant, Sons of Jacob, His chosen ones!¹⁴ He is the LORD our God; His judgments are in all the earth.¹⁵ Remember His covenant forever, The word which He commanded to a thousand generations,¹⁶ *The covenant* which He made with Abraham, And His oath to Isaac.¹⁷ He also confirmed it to Jacob for a statute, To Israel as an everlasting covenant,¹⁸ Saying, "To you I will give the land of Canaan, As the portion of your

inheritance."¹⁹ When they were only a few in number, Very few, and strangers in it,²⁰ And they wandered about from nation to nation, And from *one* kingdom to another people,²¹ He permitted no man to oppress them, And He reproved kings for their sakes, *saying*,²² "Do not touch My anointed ones, And do My prophets no harm."

A Call to WORSHIP

Ephesians 5:

²⁹ for no one ever hated his own flesh, but **nourishes and cherishes** it, just as Christ also *does* the church,³⁰ because we are members of His body.³¹ FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER AND SHALL BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE, AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH.³² This mystery is great; but I am speaking with **reference to Christ and the church.**

Who is YOUR God?

- His judgements (vs.14)
- His covenant - Abraham (vs.15,16)
- His oath - Isaac
- His confirmations - Jacob (vs.17)
- His sovereignty-(vs.21) permission, protection, reproving kings

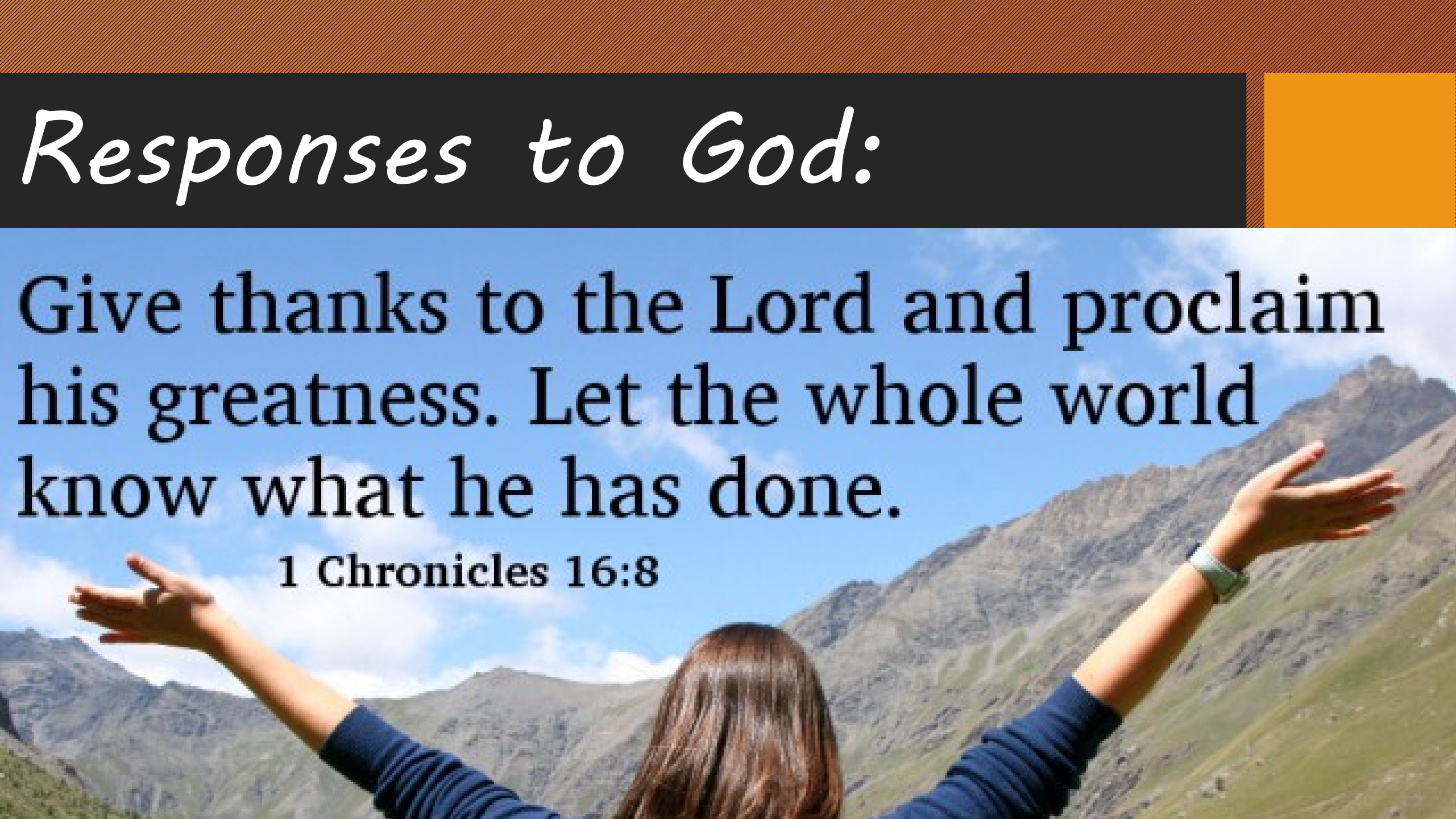
You are His Ark/Temple

Ephesians 2:

¹⁹ So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household,²⁰ having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner *stone*,²¹ in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord,²² in whom you also are being built together **into a dwelling of God** in the Spirit.



1 Peter 2:

4 ¶ And coming to Him as to a living stone which has been rejected by men, but is choice and precious in the sight of God,⁵ you also, as living stones [plural], are being built up as a spiritual house [singular] for a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

Responses to God:

- Give thanks (8)
- Call upon Him (Name)
- Make known - testimonies!
- Sing to Him (9) personal praise
- Sing praises new songs Ps 40:3

Responses to God:

- *Speak/meditate*
- *Glory IN (10)*
- *Glad hearts*
- *Seek the Lord (11) & His strength*
- *SeeK His Face!*

Responses to God:

- Remember (15)
- Tell His glory - nations (24)
- Ascribe to the Lord (28)
- Bring an offering (29) grain
- Worship in holy clothing

Responses to God:

- Tremble before Him - earth (30)
- Nature's response (31-33)
- Then say:
 - save, gather, deliver (35)
- AMEN! (36)
